

#### **Update on Courses**

The New Year will be a busy time for diabetes centre staff, with three courses running. The Primary Care Course runs on Tuesday afternoons for 5 weeks, starting on 10<sup>th</sup> January. This course is a basic introduction to all aspects of diabetes. Application forms will have been sent out when you receive this.



On 21st February we have the insulin course, a one day course introducing insulin therapy and its use in type 2 diabetes. We also have diabetes Foot Assessment training for 2 hours on 12th January, 3rd February and 9<sup>th</sup> February.
